- Please find the latest update regarding the upcoming Water System Improvement Project in lower Nuuanu (Dowsett/Alika/Wood).
 - The Board of Water Supply reviewed all submitted bids. The construction job was awarded, and a contract was executed to RMY Construction, Inc. on April 10, 2023.
 - A Notice to Proceed to the contractor is planned to be issued by October 2023. This starts the contractor's obligation to complete the project within the contracted time (365 days). Please note that construction work cannot begin until all the required documents and permits have been approved.
 - This project still needs approval from the State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD). This state agency reviews and approves projects in each county across the state. We have yet to determine how long the approval from this agency will take, as they are severely backed up. Please note we are also competing for reviews and approvals with other city and state agencies. The BWS is committed to working with and providing the necessary paperwork, as requested by SHPD.
- 9 The supply chain shortage also affects construction. Pipe materials have been delayed up to 18 to 24 months.
- Due to the information above (permit delays and supply shortages), we are not able to determine an exact time when work will begin. However, we estimate it won't be until the end of 2024, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
- We appreciate your understanding and will provide the board with additional information about this upcoming project when it becomes available.
