Effective on Monday, August 22, 2022, the Department of Transportation Services (DTS) and Oahu Transit Services (OTS) will upgrade TheBus express service with "New" Route U1 Campus Connector Express and additional express trips for routes with load capacity issues. Rider Alerts for these changes are attached.

> TheBus express routes provide commuter weekday service during the AM and PM peak periods between island-wide communities and Downtown Honolulu. Pre-pandemic, selected express routes continued to the University of Hawaii Manoa (UH) serving other schools located along the route. Due to the effects of the pandemic, TheBus service was modified system-wide to address a significant 60% decrease in ridership and included cost-saving reductions to island-wide express routes such as eliminating the UH express segment and decreasing the number of scheduled trips for each express route. Although ridership is still down by approximately 40% of pre-pandemic levels, the current level of service for several express routes is not sufficient to accommodate increasing ridership and, in light of rising inflation/fuel costs, reinstating the UH express segment with Express Route U1 and extending service to Kapiolani Community College (KCC) offers a convenient/economical commute option for the schools located along the route.

"New" Route U1 Campus Connector Express

10 11 12

Replaces the former Downtown/UH express segment that was eliminated during the pandemic.

13 14

Provides express connections to UH/KCC for island-wide express routes that directly serve Downtown Honolulu.

15 16

Travels through the areas of Downtown, Makiki, Moiliili, and Kaimuki. Services selected bus stops adjacent to schools and transfer points.

17 18 19

Operates on school days only during the AM and PM peak periods. Pilot basis for the FY22-23 school year.
